Workshop: Designing an Atlas of RtD

Duration: ~3.5h

Number of participants: 9-12

This workshop will be a group exercise to speculate about an “atlas” of Research through Design – a database, a library, an aggregator, a gallery, or something entirely different. It will be a facilitated thought experiment that will help us think about the wider landscape of Design Research and ask: “What if we had a shared repository of Research through Design projects? What would it look like? How would we use it? How might examples from your lab fit within its structures? What are its limitations?” During the workshop we plan to discuss the concept of the atlas, its audience, and its contents.

Who can participant? researchers from the lab and any other related lab from the university; PhD or master students.
