2 a	We would like to conduct a formal, yet conversational, video-recorded interview that will last 20-30 minutes, framed around your area(s) of interest / expertise.	In some cases, we would like to coincide the video-recorded interview with (i) an (audio-recorded) research interview and (ii) a 'lab walkabout', which may be video-recorded. Please consider if there is somewhere quiet where we can record the interview (e.g. an office) and let us know if we need to book a space in advance. We will obtain written consent after the interview.
2b	We will also collect 'b-roll' footage (e.g. shots of your building, labs, workshops, etc / close-ups of materials, tools, sketches, prototypes, etc).
